Success for All Elementary Schools in Arizona Gain on AIMS – Reading

Arizona elementary schools using the Success for All reading program once again made significant gains on the Arizona Instrument to Measure Standards (AIMS) – Reading scale. **From 2006 to 2009, Arizona Success for All schools had an 11.3 percentage-point increase in the number of students in grades 3–6 who met or exceeded standards.** Arizona schools overall declined by 1.3 percentage points.

Schools that made outstanding gains for this period include:

- Los Ninos Elementary in Sunnyside: **44.3%**
- Granada Primary in Alhambra: **36.0%**
- Ocotillo Elementary in Sunnyside: **32.3%**
- Santa Clara Elementary in Sunnyside: **30.7%**
- Granada East School in Alhambra: **26.3%**
- Montebello Elementary in Alhambra: **11.4%**

In addition, the following schools are performing above the state average: Andalusia Primary, Sevilla Elementary, and Westwood Primary in Alhambra; and Liberty Elementary in Sunnyside.
