Success for All Middle Schools in Pennsylvania Gain on PSSA – Reading

Pennsylvania middle schools using the Success for All reading program once again made outstanding gains on the Pennsylvania System of School Assessment (PSSA) – Reading test. **From 2006 to 2009, Pennsylvania Success for All schools had a 10.0 percentage-point increase in the number of students in grades 6–8 who scored at proficient and above.** Overall, Pennsylvania schools increased by 5.0 percentage points.

Schools that made outstanding gains for this period include:

- West Oak Lane Charter in Philadelphia: **21.0%**
- Smedley Middle School in Chester Upland: **20.2%**
- Main Street Middle School in Chester Upland: **11.8%**
